2020 VISION



- Millington Municipal Schools 2020 Vision is to have our students and staff return safely to a healthy environment on Aug. 10.
- Our students' physical, academic, social-emotional, and mental health is the guiding principle of our 2020 Vision.
- Also, we understand that the health and well-being of our staff is vital. Our vision is to provide all the support that allows our staff to be the most productive and effective for your student(s).



- Our Vision includes the following:
 - ▶ Promote Behaviors that Reduce the Spread of COVID-19
 - Maintain Healthy Environment
 - Maintain Healthy Operations
 - ▶ Be Prepared to make any needed academic or social adjustment to support education for all of Millington.



- At this point, our Vision is to adhere to the currently approved 2020-2021 academic calendar while using all health care precautions available.
- We have planned for different school operating scenarios.
- Our reopening scenarios are guided by CDC, state, and local health department recommendations.
- ► The results of the parental survey were used to help formulate the scenarios.



- Our 2020 Vision has Millington Municipal Schools opening school on August 10th using a Hybrid System.
- ► This Hybrid System allows us to reduce the number of students in the building each day. (Helps in social distancing)
- ▶ The Hybrid System limits the potential exposure time of students and staff.
- The Hybrid System allows for increased sanitizing and cleaning.
- ▶ The Hybrid System hopefully will only be needed for a short time until we get the all clear to return to full face to face school.



Hybrid System

- ▶ Students in PreK- 2nd Grade attend School Monday Thursday.
- ► Functional Skills and Special Ed Pre-K students attend school Monday-Friday.
- ▶ Students who receive special education services for resource and/or coteach attend school Monday –Thursday.
- Students in Grades 3-12 will attend School 2 days a week.
 - ▶ Last Name A- J will attend Monday and Wednesday.
 - Last Name K- Z will attend Tuesday and Thursday.
 - Friday will be a day of Virtual School for all but Functional Skills and Special Ed. Pre-K students.



All Virtual Option

- MMSD will offer an all virtual option for any parents who have strong reservations as it relates to sending their children to school in person.
- Parents will receive a phone survey to opt in for the all virtual option.
- We will send out information for families to opt in to the all virtual option in the next few days.
- Students will attend online learning 5 days a week virtually from home.
- ▶ This will be a semester long commitment.
- Students will have access to TN State standards, high quality instructional resources, a computer, a hotspot if needed and oversight and communication with a MMSD TN certified teacher.

Transportation



- MMSD contacts with Durham School Services and is regulated by requirements set forth by the Department of Transportation.
- Parents are encouraged to provide transportation for their children if possible, to assist with social distancing requirements.
- Busing will be available but limited by social distancing requirements.

School Health



- Classrooms are setup for social distancing of 6 feet.
- Wearing of masks by staff and students while in groups or transitions is expected.
- Schools will have structured times for student handwashing and hand sanitizing stations will be available throughout all schools.
- Students and staff will be instructed in proper handwashing techniques.
- Students and staff will be trained in proper health hygiene and disease transmission prevention measures.
- Nurses are available in all our schools and we have strategies for identifying children that may not feel well or show symptoms of sickness.
