Updated COVID-19 Non-Household and Household Contact Procedures
12/18/2020

On December 3th, 2020 the Tennessee Department of Health issued new procedures for Releasing Cases and Contacts From Isolation and Quarantine.

On December 4th, 2020 the Shelby County Health Department issued New Quarantine Guidelines which mirrored the procedures released from the Tennessee Department of Health.

Millington Municipal Schools will implement that following procedures starting January 4, 2021.

Non-Household Contacts

Non-Household contacts must quarantine after exposure to a case, regardless if the case was symptomatic. **TDH and CDC recommend a 14- day quarantine.** Acceptable alternatives to a 14- day quarantine include:

- After Day 7 (returning to regular activities on Day 8) if the contact does not have symptoms or fever **and** if they **test negative by a PCR collected** after Day 5.
 - Copy of negative PCR must be scanned to schoolhealth@millingtonschools.org, or copy taken to Family Resource Center at 4992 Second Avenue.
 - Parent/Guardian will sign a statement at their student's school indicating that have completed 7 days of quarantine and have had no symptoms and supplied a negative PCR collected after Day 5.
 - Coordinated School Health will communicate with school administration and return to school date.

Household Contacts

Household contacts must quarantine as long as they are exposed to the case, and for a 7-14 day period beyond their last exposure. TDH and CDC recommend a 24- day quarantine. Acceptable alternatives to a 24- day quarantine include:

- After 17 days (10 days of quarantine with positive case and 7 additional days for testing and results) if the contact does not have symptoms and if they test negative by a PCR test after Day 5
 - Copy of negative PCR test must be scanned to schoolhealth@millingtonschools.org, or copy taken to Family Resource Center at 4992 Second Avenue.
 - Parent/Guardian will sign a statement at their student's school indicating that have completed 17 days of quarantine and have had no symptoms and supplied a negative PCR test collected after Day 5.
 - Coordinated School Health will communicate with administration return to school date.
